The initial reason behind the private project "A week in September 2001 - september-2001.net" are photos of New York, which Reinhard Karger took during the period between September 8th and September 16th, 2001, a total of over 200 shots. All photos were exposed on negative film then scanned and shown to the public for the first time in 2011 in the context of an exhibition.



"A Week in September 2001- september-2001.net" offers an opportunity for reflection and participation, showing the skyline without zooming in, showing the timeline of the catastrophe without voyeurism. The desaster of September 11th began on a picturesque morning with magical photos of a still intact silhouette. The last sunrise between the twin towers shows an innocent morning - the first sunset shows helpless despair. The

World Trade Center collapses, bringing the 20th century to a close, leaving an apocalyptic cloud of dust, a painful fracture.

"A Week in September 2001" creates a chance to share personal memories of that day - currently 377 stories. And everyone is invited to contribute: Where were you on September 11th?:
